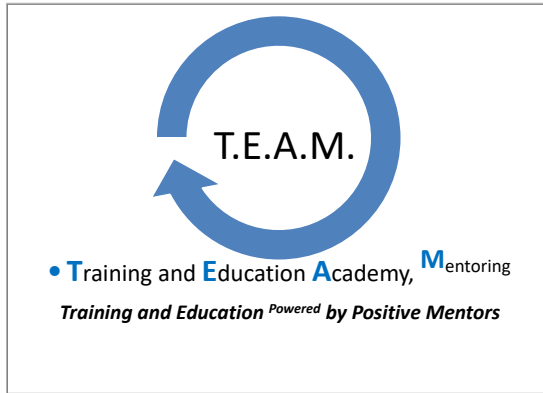

Mission

To provide a Christian home to help single, pregnant, homeless women improve life for themselves & their children.

T.E.A.M. PROGRAM

The O'Connor House staff and volunteers have worked together to conceive a Training, Education Academy & Mentoring (T.E.A.M.) Program. The program is designed to lead these women to self-sufficiency and strengthen the next generation.

GOAL:

The mentoring program offers these women strong role models who encourage them to set and achieve personal and professional goals, while completing instructional modules in parenting, self-esteem and character building and life skills all with the goal to graduate from the "Academy."

WHO ARE THE MOMS?

The women are typically between the ages of 18-25. She has completed her high school degree and is working or she is striving to obtain her high school diploma. A young woman may be expectant or recently become a parent. She may have one or more children.



THE RIPPLE EFFECT

Just imagine throwing a pebble in the pond. What do you see? Ripples form directly around the pebble and then radiate outward into wider circles. One small change can have an enormous impact. The impact is undeniable. What if you could have this effect for a woman and her family?

MENTOR OVERVIEW

A mentor is a spiritually-centered, called, and committed Christian woman who wants to apply the biblical principle of investing in the next generation, as found in 2 Timothy 2:2 - *And what you heard from me through many witnesses entrust to faithful people who will have the ability to teach others as well.*

She is willing to meet weekly (8 hours per month on average) for a minimum of one year to invest in herself, and in another. She wants an opportunity to give back much of what she has been given in life. She recognizes the potential in each woman and is committed to support and encourage positive growth.

MENTOR SELECTION

All potential mentors go through a selection and training process that includes:

- Submitting an application
- Participating in an interview
- Providing references
- Completing a background check
- Participating in mentoring training
- Participating in ongoing training and support
